The Red River and You Teachers Institute is a week long international 'hands-on, minds-on' course in the summer. The institute, through the Center for Watershed Education, travels up and down the Red River of the North watershed in a new area of the basin each year. Attendees work on watershed science, history, geography, curriculum-based water and cultural history activities, interpretive tours, field experience, and educational strategy discussions. Participants also develop a connection to educational resources and to each other.



PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

- To help educators understand and incorporate Red River of the North watershed education activities into their learning outcomes.
- To enhance knowledge, skills, and motivation of teachers and educators to teach about our local watershed and its importance in the science, history, geography, and cultural aspects of the Red River watershed.
- To get connected with educational resources available to teach watershed education concepts.
- To enhance creative thinking and problem-solving skills while learning about the value of the Red River basin in sustaining human culture.
- To meet educators from Minnesota, Manitoba, and North Dakota who live and teach in the Red River watershed.
- To expand learning across the grade span of students.
